What changes can we offer to amend the CJO to better protect you and the people you represent while preserving constitutional liberties?

Here are four areas to consider:

- 1) Pretrial release, decarceration, defendants in custody, jail policies, and related issues.
- 2) Statutory timelines, due process, and constitutional provisions.
- 3) Improvement of court technology, remote appearances, ensuring confidential communications with our clients, and related issues.
- 4) Juvenile issues, such as release, timelines, DHS visitation and services.

We can be the most effective when advocating for you and your clients if you **send a brief description of the problem/concern AND a proposed solution, such as specific statutory language that should be changed or added. Please provide feedback by April 2, 2020** so OCDLA can provide our first round of feedback. Of course, as things continue to develop, continue to email the Board members with your ideas and suggestions.
