



Jury selection is the first move on the chess board. It's the kick-off, the tip-off, the first pitch. It is when a defense attorney can finally see the people who will decide the client's fate. An effective jury selection can make or break a case and must be done thoroughly and carefully. Jury selection not only should keep bad jurors off the panel but should also be a mechanism to build the jury's trust in you as the storyteller and expert in the courtroom.

Sections I–IV discuss the fundamental right to a jury trial in state court and the composition of the jury, juror qualifications, and the “Fair Cross Section” requirements of a venire. Section V discusses the challenge to the venire panel. Sections VI–VIII are a trial attorney's primary mid-trial reference because they discuss For Cause Challenges, Peremptory Challenges (including *Batson* challenges), and Preservation of Jury Selection Issues for Appeal.

### I. Foundation of the Right to a Jury Trial in State Court

#### A. Constitutional Sources

In all criminal cases, the accused has the right to a trial by an impartial jury. [Article I, section 11, of the Oregon Constitution](#); [Sixth Amendment](#) of the United States Constitution. The guarantee of trial by an “impartial jury” means “trial by a jury that is not biased in favor of or against either party, but is influenced in making its decision only by evidence produced at trial and legal standards provided by the trial court.” [State v. Amini, 331 Or 384, 391, 15 P3d 541, 545 \(2000\)](#).

#### B. State Constitutional Right to Jury Trial Is Broader Than Federal Right

The Oregon appellate courts have held that the right to a jury trial extends to some violations when that violation retains substantial penal characteristics. [Brown v. Multnomah County Dist. Ct., 280 Or 95, 109-111, 570 P2d 52 \(1977\)](#) (jury trial for DUII violation); [State v. Fuller, 354 Or 295, 311 P3d 861 \(2013\)](#) (jury trial for theft charged as a violation).

In deciding whether the accused has a right to a jury trial, the court considers:

- The type of offense.
- The nature of the prescribed penalty.
